September 19-23

Language Arts Objectives (Phonics, Reading, Writing)

Students will:

- identify letters and initial and final sounds for **Mm, Tt**
- continue to practice letters and sounds for **Aa, Tt, Bb, Ll, Ff, Hh, Pp, Ss, Mm, Uu, Rr, Cc, Gg, Ii, Nn, Dd, Oo, Jj, Vv, Ww, Ee, Xx, Kk, Yy, Zz, Qu, qu**
- be introduced to sight words: for, on, are
- continue to practice sight words: the, of, and, to, in, is, you, that, it, he, was

Weekly Story: *Mission Impossible*

Essential Question: What makes a place special?

Weekly Question: How does imagination make a place seem different?

Students will:

- identify and describe characters
- understand vocabulary: cube, circle, square, triangle

Activities:

- Spelling and reading sight words
- Read **Ten Black Dots** and make a class book called **Ten Dots** where students color ten dots, cut them out and make them into a picture

Assessments: daily worksheets, teacher observations, classroom centers
