September 26-30

Language Arts Objectives (Phonics, Reading, Writing)

Students will:

- identify letters and initial and final sounds for **Ss** and initial and medial sounds for **Aa**
- continue to practice letters and sounds for Aa, Tt, Bb, Ll, Ff, Hh, Pp, Ss, Mm, Uu, Rr, Cc, Gg, Ii, Nn, Dd, Oo, Jj, Vv, Ww, Ee, Xx, Kk, Yy, Zz, Qu, qu
- read words in the -am and -at word families
- be introduced to sight words: his, they, be
- continue to practice sight words: the, of, and, to, in, is, you, that, it, he, was, for, on, are, as, we
