## October 10-14

### Language Arts Objectives (Phonics, Reading, Writing)

Students will:

- identify letters and initial and final sounds for **Nn**, initial and medial sounds for **Ii**
- continue to practice letters and sounds for **Aa, Tt, Bb, Ll, Ff, Hh, Pp, Ss, Mm, Uu, Rr, Cc, Gg, Ii, Nn, Dd, Oo, Jj, Vv, Ww, Ee, Xx, Kk, Yy, Zz, Qu, qu**
- read words in the **-in, -ig, -id, -od, -og** word families
- be introduced to sight words: **from, or, has**
- continue to practice sight words: **the, of, and, to, in, is, you, that, it, he, was, for, on, are, as, we, his, they, be, no, have**
