

# Mrs. Minor's Weekly Objectives

## November 14-18

### Language Arts Objectives (Phonics, Reading, Writing)

Students will:

- identify letters and initial and final sounds for **Ff** and initial and medial sounds for **Oo**
- continue to practice letters and sounds for **Aa, Tt, Bb, Ll, Ff, Hh, Pp, Ss, Mm, Uu, Rr, Cc, Gg, Ii, Nn, Dd, Oo, Jj, Vv, Ww, Ee, Xx, Kk, Yy, Zz, Qu, qu**
- read words in the **-ock, -eck, -uck** word families
- read and write words with short a
- be introduced to sight words: **you, said, there**
- continue to practice sight words: **the, of, and, to, in, is, you, that, it, he, was, for, on, are, as, we, his, they, be, no, have, from, or, has, by, me, what, little, she, this, when**
- identify opposites.

**Essential Question: What do living things need?**

Students will:

- find text structure
- ask and answer questions about text structure
- understand vocabulary: **bees, honey, nectar, hive**

**Assessments:** daily worksheets, teacher observations, classroom centers

### Math Objectives

**Finish Topic 5: Classify and Count Data**

Students will:

- classify objects into categories and tell why they are in each category.
- count how many objects are in different categories.
- use counting to compare how many objects are in categories.
- sort objects by size or by number.
- tell whether the way objects have been sorted, counted and compared make sense.
