Language Arts Objectives (Phonics, Reading, Writing)

Students will:

- identify letters and initial sounds for Ww and Yy, initial and medial sounds for Ee
- REVIEW initial blends bl, cl, fl, gl, pl, sl, br, cr, dr, fr, gr, pr, tr, st, sp, and final blends nd, -ft, -sk, -st
- continue to practice letters and sounds for Aa, Tt, Bb, Ll, Ff, Hh, Pp, Ss, Mm, Uu, Rr, Cc, Gg, Ii, Nn, Dd, Oo, Jj, Vv, Ww, Ee, Xx, Kk, Yy, Zz, Qu, qu
- read and write words with short a and short i
- be introduced to sight words: do, how, my
- continue to practice sight words: the, of, and, to, in, is, you, that, it, he, was, for, on, are, as, we, his, they, be, no, have, from, or, has, by, me, what, little, she, this, when, you, said, there, use, go, which, one, do

Weekly Story: Run, Jump, and Swim

<u>Essential Question:</u> What do living things need? <u>Weekly Question:</u> Why is exercise important?

Students will:

- find text structures
- > find important details using text structures
- understand vocabulary: swim, push, climb, carry

Assessments: daily worksheets, teacher observations, classroom centers

Math Objectives REVIEW ADDITION

Students will:

- add numbers together.
- write an equation to show addition.
- use the plus sign and equal sign in an equation.
- solve addition problems.
- use equations to represent and explain addition.

INTRODUCE GRAPHING

Students will:

- organize items by using tally marks.
- use tally marks to fill in a bar graph.
- use bar graph to answer questions.

Language Arts Testing for REPORT CARDS

- ACRead left/right, top/bottom, page by page.
- ACLetter recognition: Identifies upper-& lower-case letters.
- ALLETTER sounds: Produces letter sounds.
- Identify and produce rhyming words.
- AscRead CVC words (e.g. dog, cat, etc).
- Recognize long and short vowel sounds.
- Read common high frequency words by sight: the, of, and, to, in, is, you, that, it, he, was, for, on, are, as, we, his, they, be, no, have, from, or, has, by, me, what, little, she, this, when, you, said
- Can read grade level text.
- ASSIdentify story characters, setting, plot.
- ASCRetell main idea/key details of texts.
- Asswer questions about texts.
- Mrites for a specific purpose.
- MCUse capitalization, punctuation, and phonetic spelling.

Assessments: daily worksheets, teacher observations, classroom centers

Math Testing for REPORT CARDS

- Count to 100 or higher by ones and tens.
- Write numbers 0-20 or higher without reversals.
- Recognize numbers 0-10.
- Count objects one to one in various arrangements.
- Identify if objects are greater than, less than, or equal.
- Can solve simple addition problems.
- Create, extend, and give appropriate rule for patterns.
- Identify positions of objects.
- **Name and describe 2D shapes: circle, triangle, square, rectangle and hexagon AND give two attributes for each shape.
- Recognize position words: left, right, under, over, behind.
- Make and continue patterns: AB, ABB, AABB, ABC
- Sort objects by an attribute: color, shape, size.
- **E**Compare sets: more, less, equal.
