## Math Testing for REPORT CARDS

Count to 100 or higher by ones and tens.
Write numbers 0-20 or higher without reversals.

Recognize numbers 0-10.

Count objects one to one in various arrangements.

Identify if objects are greater than, less than, or equal.

Can solve simple addition problems.

Create, extend, and give appropriate rule for patterns.

Identify positions of objects.

Name and describe 2D shapes: circle, triangle, square, rectangle and hexagon AND give two attributes for each shape.
Recognize position words: left, right, under, over, behind.

Make and continue patterns: AB, ABB, AABB, ABC

WSort objects by an attribute: color, shape, size.

Compare sets: more, less, equal.

Assessments: daily worksheets, teacher observations, classroom centers
